



Planning a Neighborhood Clean-Up



Select a date → Coordinate with Keep Greenwood County Beautiful by calling 864-941-3370 → Work with the County/City to set a date & time for a special curbside pick-up in your neighborhood.



Decide if you are going to have a general area clean-up of common properties, streets, streams, etc. You may just decide to have a pick-up of household items.

Set a goal of how many streets you would like to clean up.



Consider items in your house or property that you will throw away.

Consider areas beyond your property (if applicable).

Plan for refreshments & water on your neighborhoods clean-up day for the volunteers.

Set date & time for a neighborhood clean-up just before the Solid Waste pick-up day.

Discuss how much you plan to help others (i.e. disabled, elderly).



Get Healthy Greenwood Neighborhoods to print fliers about 2 weeks before the general clean-up and the pick-up of everyone's items.



Call and visit your neighbors and have your association members round up additional volunteers.

Review the items that should be recycled, list those that can and cannot be picked up from the Solid Waste Services instructions.

Conduct your general area clean-up on a day just before the pick-up day (if applicable).



Gather the items that you want picked up from your house and property and get it to the curb by the day before the pick up.
